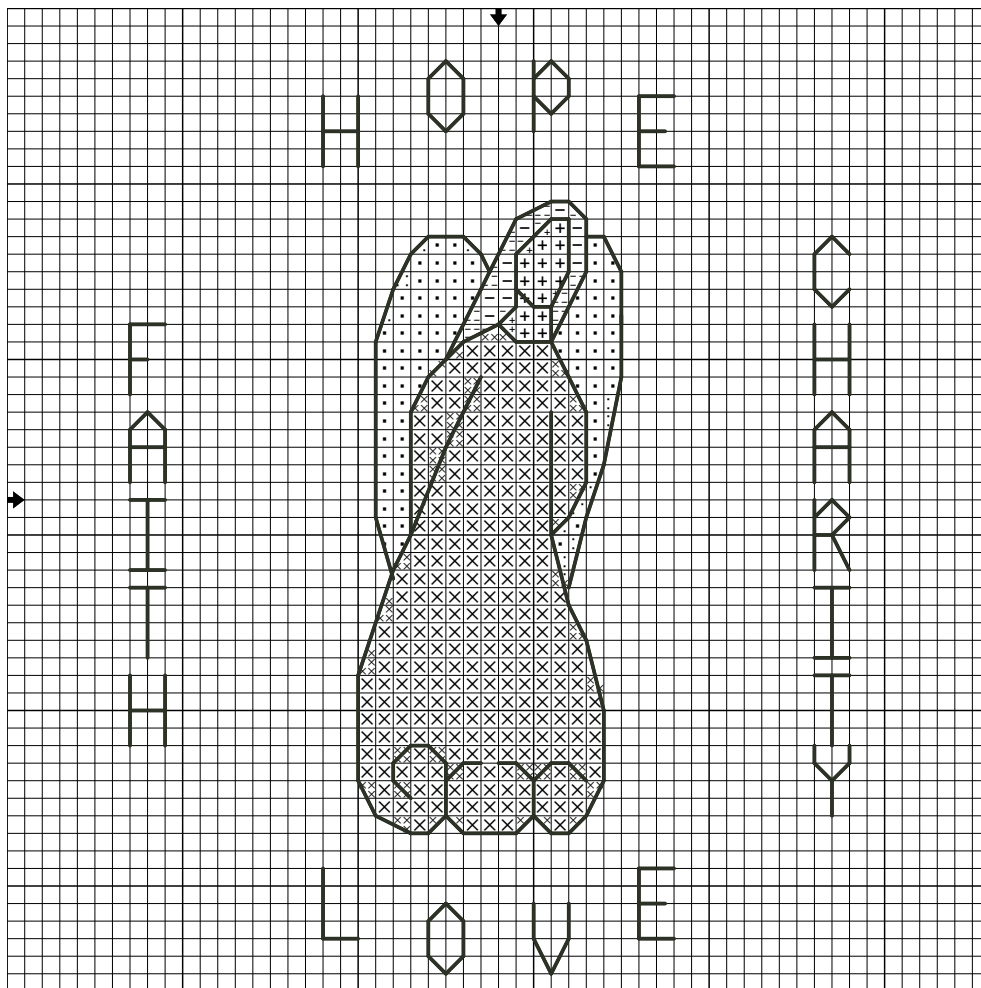
The April drawing will be for one LE Kit "After the Showers" from Stitches' Village Designs

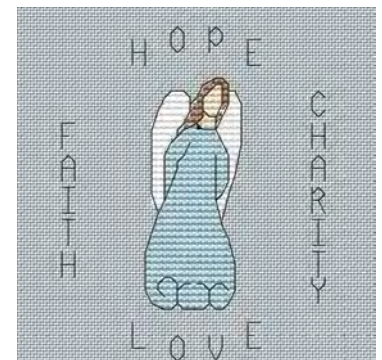
