Exciting things are happening in The Stitchers' Village!

I am happy to report that we now have a designated “wholesale” building in our Village square that will host companies that sell their wares to retail shops. These merchants will be located in shops 31-40 in the Village square on the main Village site. Their links will also be found on the left hand side of the social area of TSV. The first of these is Norden Crafts who is the distributor of the lovely Birds of a Feather Mystery Sampler from Brenda Gervais as well as a large catalog of other products. You may visit the Norden Craft link to see weekly new releases from the designers and products distributed by Norden Craft.

There is also a building newly dedicated to “boutiques” in the Village square. These will be shops 11– 20 in the Village square on the main site. Their links will also be found on the left hand side of the social area. The first of these to join us are The Gift of Stitching online cross stitch magazine and Pine Glen Designs. These will be an interesting and exciting enhancement to The Stitchers' Village and offer an opportunity to access some wonderful products.

In conjunction with these two buildings being designated for the wholesale and boutique shops, you may notice that Laurel's Stitchery is now located in shop number 21 in the Village square. This will allow for the Village shops to be in shops 1 - 10 and 21 - 30. There are some new shops interested in a store front on TSV, so look for new additions soon. Also, be sure to visit the shops of TSV when you are looking for your supplies as we have some very excellent stores at our fingertips on The Stitchers' Village and we should support our “local” merchants.

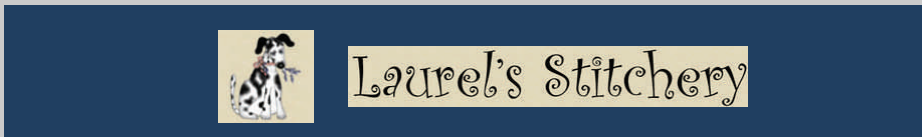
