

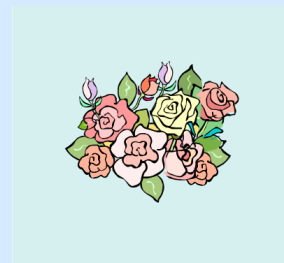

It is with great regret that we say goodbye to The Gift of Stitching Magazine. The May/June 2012 issue will be the last. Kirsten reports that back issues will be available for purchase on her site for the near future. She will also continue to be involved in the needlework industry.

Kirsten found that the “sharing” of her product was so widespread, that it cost her a great deal of income. Many of you may be aware of the copyright infringement issues being experienced by needlework designers. It may seem innocent to forward a pdf file or copy and pass along a chart, but it is, indeed, theft. Many people do not understand that the Gift of Stitching Magazine is a business just like the needlework design companies are businesses. The owners are producing a product and rely on their businesses for their livelihood. When their product is copied and distributed without their permission and without them receiving compensation, they become victims of crime. Sadly, as in the case of TGOS and several designers, it causes them to quit. I hope that everyone will give thought to this perspective and take a stand against copyright infringement and theft. I hate that we have lost such a wonderful publication. Kirsten put in a lot of hard work to offer such an excellent digital magazine. I look forward to what she will be doing in the future for the needlework industry.

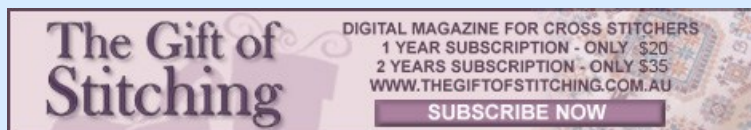
