



Symbol

This design was inspired by a television show I watched on the Smithsonian channel called "Mystic Britain". The show was filming in a very old church and discussing some markings on a wall. They explained that some symbols which are, today, thought to be evil (such as the pentagram) were, in historic times, considered wards against evil. An intertwining design might capture a demon and keep it there - going round and round. A little sparkle in the middle might attract attention, also!

Your fabric choice will be the starting point for the colors you use.

Added to the center is a "volcano" margerite bead and a 2mm crystal. The model is stitched on a PTP fabric orphan Lugana with WDW thread.
