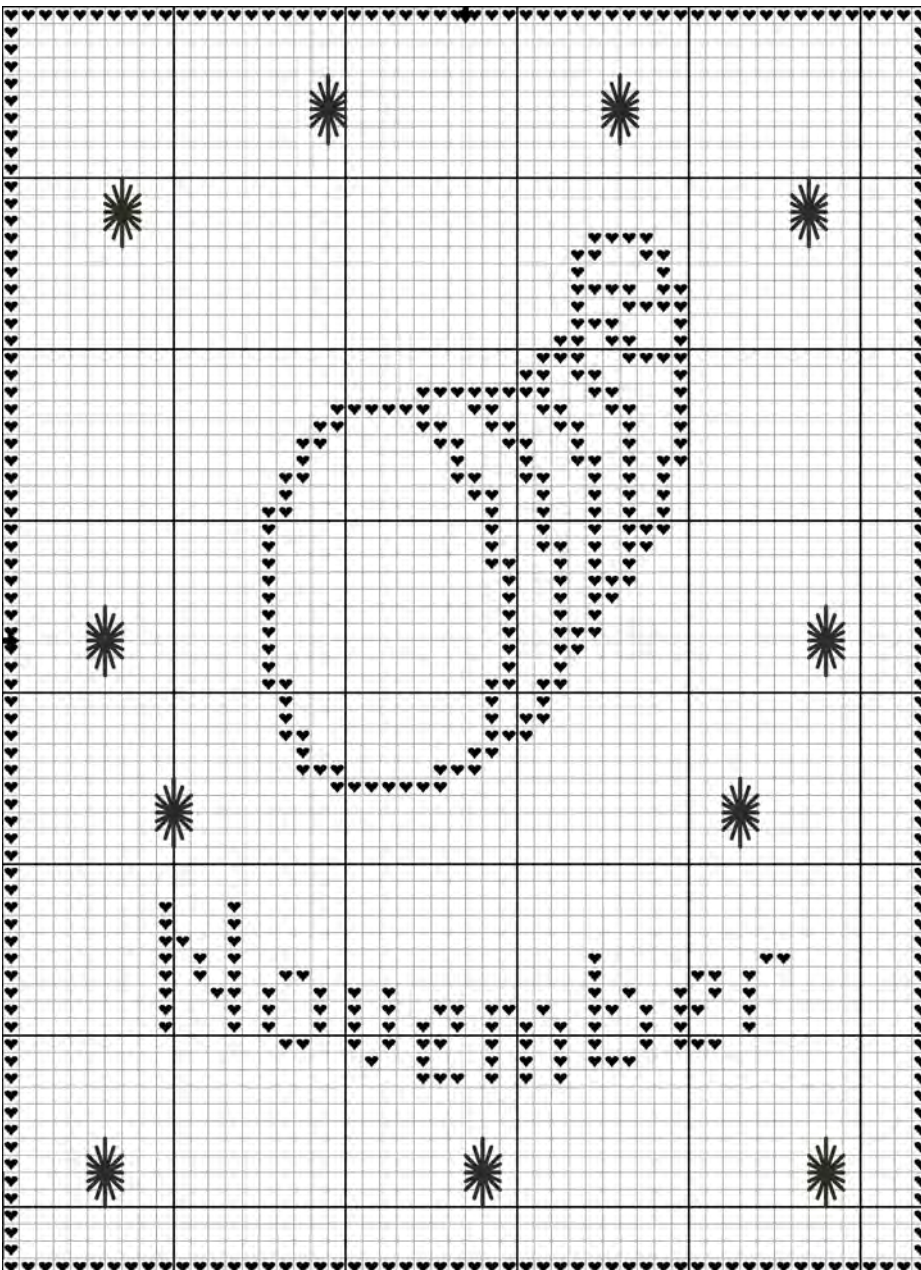

2021 Twelve Part Series - Section 11 November

This is the current section in a twelve part series for this year. The sections will incorporate the name of the month, a specialty stitch and a different motif each month. Each piece will be the same size and shown with a boxed line border. The complete size with all 12 sections stitched into one project (with three across and four down) is 160w x 293h. Each individual box will be 54w x 74h—the line of the border will be shared by connecting sections. You may wish to leave the border off but use it for layout guide of the project. Fabric size and color as well as thread choice is completely up to your personal preference! Enjoy!
